



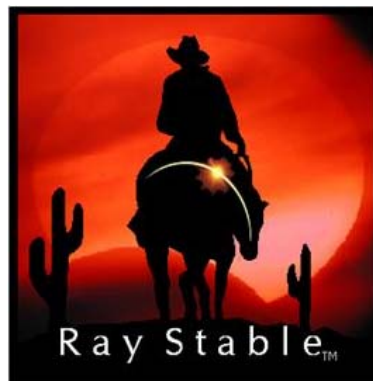

THE STORY:

Ray Stable is a mysterious cowboy who exists somewhere in between the harsh urban city and the calm tranquility of the western countryside. Nobody knows exactly where Ray came from, but the wild desert country outside city limits is his playground. Although he is a cowboy, he's no stranger to the dark alley street culture of the big city. He ventures into city limits seeking answers to life's greatest questions but disappears into the landscape in solitude.

Some describe his life as tragic. The love of his life was killed in a car crash on a long deserted desert highway, with Ray at the wheel, surviving the horrible incident.
